Lower Tail	Golden Pheasant Tippetts - Natural --> <b>Wapsi Golden Pheasant Tippetts - Natural</b>
Upper Tail	Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural --> <b>Wapsi Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural</b>
Rib	Flat Tinsel - Silver --> <b>UTC Mylar Tinsel - Large, Silver</b>
Body 1, 2	Seals Fur Dubbing - Yellow, Orange --> <b>African Goat Dubbing - Yellow, Orange</b>
Thread 2	Traditional Silk or Lightweight Synthetic - Black --> <b>UTC Ultra Thread - 70 Denier, Black</b>
Body Hackle	Hen or Rooster Feather - Black --> <b>Whiting Genetic Hen Cape Feather - Black</b>
Body 3	Seals Fur Dubbing - Medium Blue --> <b>African Goat Dubbing - Fl. Blue/Black Blend</b>
Front Hackle	Hen Feather - Black --> <b>Whiting Genetic Hen Cape Feather - Black</b>

Tail	Golden Pheasant Crest and Indian Crow Feathers → <b>G. Pheasant Crest / Indian Crow Red Ringneck Patch</b>
Tip	Ostrich Herl - Black → <b>Nature's Spirit Ostrich Herl - Black</b>
Rib	Twisted Silver Tinsel and Flat Silver Tinsel → <b>Med. UTC Oval French Tinsel / Med. UTC Mylar Tinsel</b>
Body 1	Silk Floss - Lemon Yellow → <b>Ovale Pure Silk Floss - Yellow #534</b>
