Hook	Salmon Hook, Double, Low Water, Up Eye, Sizes 4-10 —> Daiichi 7131 "Double Salmon Hook" - Size 6
Thread	Lightweight Synthetic - Red —> UTC Ultra Thread - 70 Denier, Red
Tag	Oval Tinsel - Silver or Gold —> UTC Oval French Tinsel - Medium, Silver
Rib	Same as Tag above
Tail	Bucktail - Hot Orange —> White River Fly Shop Bucktail - Rust
Tail Flash	Crystal Flash - Pearl (2 strands doubled back) —> Hareline Dubbin Krystal Flash - Pearl
Abdomen	Silk or Nylon Floss - 1/2 Red & 1/2 Black —> Ovale Pure Silk Floss - Red #925, Black #4106
Under Wing	Squirrel Tail - Natural Gray —> Hareline Dubbin Squirrel Tail - Natural Gray
Wing	Golden Pheasant Tippet - Dyed Orange —> Wapsi Golden Pheasant Tippet - Natural Orange
Hackle Collar	Saddle Hackle - Hot Orange —> Nature's Spirit Fish Hunter Select - Hot Orange
Head	Same as Thread above

MATERIAL LIST

Hook (1)	Salmon Hook, Double, Low Water, Up Eye, Sizes 4-10 —> Daiichi 7131 “Double Salmon Hook” - Size 6
Thread	Middleweight Synthetic or GSP - Black —> UTC Ultra Thread - 140 Denier, Black
Tag	Oval Tinsel - Small, Silver —> UTC Oval French Tinsel - Small, Silver
Rib	Same as Tag above
Tail	Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural (2 feathers) —> Wapsi Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural
Abdomen	Silk or Nylon Floss - Black —> Ovale Pure Silk Floss - Black #4106
Hackle Collar	Hen or Rooster Feather - Black —> Whiting Genetic Hen Cape Feather - Black
Hackle Throat	Eurasian Bluejay [sub: Guinea Feather dyed Blue] —> Hareline Strung Guinea - Silver Doctor Blue
Under Wing	Bucktail - Red —> Whitetail Fly Tying Bucktail - Brilliant Red
Wing	Bucktail - Yellow —> White River Fly Shop Bucktail - Yellow
Head	Same as Thread above

- This fly can also be tied on Single, Low Water, Up Eye Salmon Hook such as a Daiichi 2421.

GREEN BUTT SKUNK

MATERIAL LIST

Hook (1)	Salmon Hook, Single, Low Water, Up Eye, Sizes 2-8 → Daichi 2421 "Salmon Hook" - Size 6
Thread	Middleweight Synthetic or GSP - Black or Red → UTC Ultra Thread - 140 Denier, Black
Tag	Flat Tinsel - Fine, Silver → UTC Mylar Tinsel - Small, Silver
Tail (2)	Strung Rooster Hackle Fibers - Red → White River Fly Shop Strung Hackle - Red
Butt	Antron Yarn, Coarse Dubbing, or Chenille - Chartreuse → Wapsi Antron Yarn - Fl. Chartreuse
Rib	Flat Tinsel - Fine, Silver → UTC Mylar Tinsel - Small, Silver
Abdomen	Coarse Dubbing or Chenille - Black → SLF Prism Dubbing - Black
Hackle	Strung Rooster Hackle - Black, Sparse → White River Fly Shop Strung Hackle - Black
Wing	Calf or Buck Tail - Natural White → Nature's Spirit Calf Tail - Natural White
Head	Same as Thread above

Notes

- Any up-eye salmon or spey style hook, such as a Tiemco 7999, will do.
- The tail on the original appears to have been a golden pheasant crest feather that were dyed red.

Hook (1)	Salmon Hook, Single, Low Water, Up Eye, Sizes 4-10 —> Daiichi 2421 "Salmon Hook" - Size 6
Thread 1	Lightweight Synthetic - Yellow —> UTC Ultra Thread - 70 Denier, Yellow
Tag	Flat Tinsel - Silver —> UTC Mylar Tinsel - Small (1/32"), Silver
Tail	Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural (2 feathers) —> Wapsi Golden Pheasant Crest - Natural
Rib	Oval Tinsel - Small, Silver —> UTC Oval French Tinsel - Small, Silver
Abdomen	Silk or Nylon Floss - 1/3 Yellow & 2/3 Red —> Ovale Pure Silk Floss - Yellow #534, Red #925
Hackle Collar	Hen or Rooster Cape - Blue —> Whitetail Fly Tying Hen Neck - Silver Doctor Blue
Thread 2	Lightweight Synthetic - Black —> UTC Ultra Thread - 70 Denier, Black
Under Wing	Secondary Wing Quill Slips - Yellow —> Hareline Goose Shoulder Quill Slips - Yellow
Wing	Bronze Mallard Flank Feather Slips - Natural —> Wapsi Bronze Mallard Flank Slips - Natural
Cheeks	Jungle Cock Nails - Small —> Jungle Cock Cape
Head	Same as Thread 2 above

1. This fly can also be tied on Double, Low Water, Up Eye Salmon Hook such as a Daiichi 7131.

RUSTY RAT

MATERIAL LIST

Hook (1)	Salmon Hook, Single, Low Water, Up Eye, Sizes 2-8 —> Daiichi 2421 "Salmon Hook" - Size 6
Thread	Middleweight Synthetic or GSP - Red —> UTC Ultra Thread - 140 Denier, Red
Tag	Oval Tinsel - Small, Gold —> UTC Oval French Tinsel - Small, Gold
Rib	Same as Tag above
Tail	Peacock Sword Slips - Natural —> Troutmen Enterprises Peacock Sword Slips
Body, Rear	Floss - Rusty Orange —> UNI Single-Strand Floss - Rusty Orange
Body, Front	Peacock Herls - Natural —> Peacock Herls - Natural (2 herls)
Under Wing	End of "Body, Rear" floss above
Wing (2)	Gray Fox - Guard Hairs —> Whitetail Fly Tying Red Fox Patch - Guard Hairs
Hackle	Rooster Cape - Grizzly, Webbed Edge Feather —> Whiting High & Dry Cape - Grizzly
Head	Same as Thread above

Notes

- Any up-eye salmon or spey style hook, such as a Tiemco 7999, will do.
- Red Fox guard hairs are shown in the video but it is more common to use Gray Fox.

LEFTY'S DECEIVER

MATERIAL LIST

Hook (1)	Saltwater Hook, Straight Eye, 1XL - Sizes 4/0-6 → Mustad 3407DT "O'Shaughnessy" Size 1/0
Thread 1	Middleweight Synthetic or GSP - White → Veevus GSP - 150 Denier, White
Tail	Saddle Hackles - White, Red, Grizzly, 3x Shank Length → Feather-Craft Chinese Rooster Saddle Hackles
Tail Flash 1	Crystal Flash - Red or Pearlescent (3 strands each side) → Krystal Flash - Red
Tail Flash 2	Flashabou - Medium, Red or Pearl (3 strands each side) → Flashabou Tinsel - The Original, Red
Abdomen	Diamond Braid - Pearl or Silver → Hareline Pearl Core Braid, Pearl White
Wing	Bucktail - White → Whitetail Fly Tying Buck Tail - Natural (White)
Over Wing	Bucktail - Red → Whitetail Fly Tying Buck Tail - Red
Thread 2	Middleweight Synthetic or GSP - Red → UTC Ultra Thread - 140 Denier, Red
Gills	Crystal Flash - Red (several strands) → Krystal Flash - Red
Head	Same as Thread 2 above

Notes

1. The Mustad 3407DT and the S71S-DT saltwater hooks are newer styles of the original Mustad 34007.
2. The color scheme shown is red over white. Other great color combinations include olive over white, chartreuse over white, blue over white, olive over yellow, brown over yellow, all white, and all black.
